

MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL  
HELD ON MARCH 16, 2021

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on March 16, 2021 at 7:42 P.M. the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Ryan Ramsey, who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Ryan Ramsey, Tim Hauber, Jennifer Voignier, Karen Henderson, Aaron Stonecipher, Mike Mustain and John Gilkey.

**Historic Preservation Committee Update and Budget Funding**

Redevelopment Director Nic Langford and Planning Director Jacob Arbital gave a brief overview and update on the Historic Preservation Committee. The Committee/Commission consists of 7 members: 4 members are present at this work session: Jim Kenney, Terri Vance, Emily Tolliver, and Lynn Lewis.

The 2020 Accomplishments are listed as follows: Identifying 100 year old homes, and selected 13 to be invited to be into the first class of acknowledges homes; completion of the masterplan of possible historic neighborhoods; completed and submitted application for Historic Neighborhood designation for Centralia Court District; Lincoln Heights Historic Neighborhood signage in place, with a planned celebration in May; Historical Society informed HPC they could no longer maintain the Town Archive, which are primarily housed in Town Hall office space.

2021 Commission Initiatives and Budget Request: Creating a GIS program to allow citizens and visitors to access historic property information, as well as walking and driving tours. Requesting Staff support and public relations support in designing a logo to brand this program; adding two more Historic Neighborhoods; announce the 2021 list of 100 year old homes and the corresponding plaques for each; Hale-McBride Cemetery Project; Rosie the Riveter Project; Eleanor Roosevelt visit to Clarksville; . The HPC is also requesting funds to secure Historic Archives. Total budget request for 2021 HPC Initiatives: \$27,500.00.
