Public Hearing:

Approval of 2021-S-02, Amending 2020-S-05, Regarding Rank Positions for Firefighters

Ordinance 2021-S-02 was presented to Council for a second reading. Council Member Mustain made a motion to approve Ordinance 2021-S-02. Council Member Gilkey seconded the motion, with the vote passing 5-2, with Council Member Stonecipher and Council Member Hauber voting nay.

Approval of 2021-G-05, Re-Establishing the Maximum Rate for the Cumulative Capital Development Fund (CCD)

Ordinance 2021-G-05, Re-Establishing Maximum Rate for the CCD Fund, was presented to Council. For the first reading, Council Member Gilkey made a motion to approve Ordinance 2021-G-05. Approval of 2021-G-06, Re-Establishing the Maximum Rate for the Cumulative Parks Fund

Council Member Voignier seconded the motion, and was carried by unanimous vote. For the second reading, Council Member Gilkey made a motion to approve Ordinance 2021-G-06. Approval of 2021-G-07, Vacating an Alley behind 125 E. Stansifer Avenue

Ordinance 2021-G-07, Vacating an Alley behind 125 E. Stansifer, was presented to Council. For the first reading, Council Member Mustain made a motion to approve Ordinance 2021-G-07. Council Member Voignier seconded the motion, with a vote of 6-0-1, with Council Member Henderson abstaining due to a conflict of interest. Due to the Ordinance not passing unanimously on the first reading, it will be brought back to the next Council meeting for a second reading.

Approval of 2021-S-03, Amending 2020-S-05, Increasing the number of Probationary Firefighters

Ordinance 2021-S-03, an Ordinance increasing the number of probationary firefighters, was presented to Council. For the first reading, Council Member Voignier made a motion to approve Ordinance 2021-S-03. Council Member Mustain seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote. For the second reading, Council Member Voignier made a motion to approve Ordinance 2021-S-03. Council Member Mustain seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote.

Approval of 2021-R-07, Transferring Property at 1439 Smyser Avenue to the Clarksville Redevelopment Commission

Resolution 2021-R-07, transferring property at 1439 Smyser Avenue, was presented to Council. Council Member Mustain made a motion to approve Ordinance 2021-R-07. Council Member Henderson seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote.

Approval of Contract with OHM Advisors for Parkwood Drainage

A contract with OHM Advisors, regarding work for the Parkwood Drainage Project: Design and Construction for Areas designated as Area 1, Area 3, Area 5 and Area 7, was presented to the Council. The estimated construction cost of this portion of the project is 3.2 million dollars. Council Member Voignier made a motion to approve contract with OHM Advisors. Council Member Mustain seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote.
