

MINUTES OF MEETING OF
THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL
HELD ON AUGUST 17, 2021

A meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on August 17, 2021 at 7:00 P.M. in the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Ramsey, who chaired the meeting.

Public Comments

- Ryan Jefferson: 1020 Sprague Street Clarksville. Mr. Jefferson spoke about the violent crimes that have occurred on Kensington and is worried about the safety of neighborhood.
- Teresa Ballew: 472 Kensington Drive, Clarksville. Feels there is a threat to the safety of everyone in her neighborhood. Ms. Ballew inquired if anything could be done about the boarded up house that was involved with the law enforcement raid in 2019.

Council Member Gilkey asked that item 5.3 Acceptance of Striping Bids for Future Public Works Projects in 2021-2022 and item 5.4 Award of Bid for 2021 Street Striping Work be removed from the consent agenda. Items were removed and voted on separately.

Council Member Henderson made a motion to approve consent agenda. Council Member Gilkey seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote.

New Business

Acceptance of Striping Bids for future Public Works Projects in 2021-22

Two contractors submitted bids for striping projects and were opened on 6/27/21. The prices are on the bid tabulation sheet and are available for viewing at the Clerk Treasurer's Office. Staff recommends Council to accept and place on file the striping bids for future Public Works Projects. Council Member Henderson made a motion to accept and place on file the Striping

Bids for future Public Works Projects in 2021-2022. Council Member Voignier seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote.

Award of Bid for 2021 Street Striping Work

The Street Striping Work for 2021, which includes Lewis & Clark Parkway, Armed Forces Way, Eastern Blvd, Applegate Lane, Hunter Station Road, Bass Pro Drive, Blackiston Mill Road, Triangle Drive and Randolph Avenue was put out for bid and the Town accepted two bids. AllTerrain Paving: \$302,967.50 and Atlantic Construction: \$311,406.26. Staff recommends accepting the bid from AllTerrain Paving in the amount of \$302,967.50. Council Member Mustain made a motion to award bid to AllTerrain Paving. Council Member Henderson seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote.

Approval of Ordinance 2021-S-06, an Ordinance Amending Ordinance 2020-S-06; Amending Job Classifications and Salary Ranges for Non Union Employees

Ordinance 2021-S-06, an Ordinance amending Job Classifications and Salary Ranges for Non Union Employees was presented to Council. For the first reading, Council Member Gilkey made a motion to approve 2021-S-06, amending two of the titles of PAT 5 and PAT 6. Council Member Henderson seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote. For the second reading, Council Member Gilkey made a motion to approve 2021-S-06, with amendment to title PAT 5 and PAT 6. Council Member Henderson seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote.

Approval of Resolution 2021-R-28, a Resolution Authorizing the filing of a Condemnation Complaint, Clarks Landing Enterprise Investments, LLC, Riverside Drive

Resolution 2021-R-28, a Resolution Authorizing the filing of a Condemnation Complaint, Clarks Landing Enterprise Investments LLC, Riverside Drive, was presented to Council. Council Member Gilkey made a motion to approve 2021-R-28. Council Member Stonecipher seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote.
