A meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on October 5, 2021 at 7:00 P.M. in the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Ramsey, who chaired the meeting.

**Public Hearings:**

-Public Hearing for Additional Appropriations for FY 2021

Having been duly advertised, the Town held a public hearing for additional appropriations in the TIF, CEDIT, and CCD funds. Manger Baity asked for comments. No one came forward to speak for or against the proposed FY 2021 Additional Appropriations. Public hearing is now closed.

-Public Hearing for Vacation of Alleys and Streets in SCMU

**Approval of Ordinance 2021-BUD-04, an Ordinance Approving Additional Appropriations for FY 2021**

**Approval of Ordinance 2021-ST-02, an Ordinance Establishing 20 MPH Speed Limits in SCMU**

**Approval of Ordinance 2021-ST-03, an Ordinance Establishing a 4-Way Stop at Main Street and Court Street**

**Approval of Resolution 2021-R-33, a Resolution Accepting Conveyance of Real Estate from the Clarksville Redevelopment Commission**

Resolution 2021-R-33, a Resolution accepting conveyance of real estate from the Clarksville Redevelopment Commission, was presented to Council. Council Member Stonecipher made a motion to approve 2021-R-33. Council Member Gilkey seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote.

**Acceptance of Quotes and Award of Sidewalk Project Contract**

Plans were developed for new and replacement sidewalks in two sections of the Blackiston Heights area, as well as Arlington Avenue, (see Attachment A in the Clerk Treasurer's Office for details). Quotes were received from 3 Contractors: 1. Libs Paving Co. - \$149,150.00 2. Dan Cristiani - \$149,200.00 3. APC - \$100,720.00. Staff recommends Council accept quotes and award Sidewalk Project contract to APC in the amount of \$100,720.00. Council Member Mustain made a motion to accept quotes and award bid to APC. Council Member Voignier seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote.

**Approval of Resolution 2021-R-34, a Resolution Accepting Maintenance of a Portion of Future Drive**

Resolution 2021-R-34, a Resolution accepting maintenance of a portion of Future Drive, was presented to Council. Council Member Stonecipher made a motion to approve 2021-R-34. Council Member Voignier seconded the motion and was carried by unanimous vote.
