

96 MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL
HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 2021

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on November 2, 2021 at 8:05 P.M. in the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Ryan Ramsey, who chaired the meeting.

Council members present: Ryan Ramsey, A.D. Stonecipher, Karen Henderson, Mike Mustain, Jennifer Voignier and John Gilkey. Absent: Tim Hauber

Discussion of Memorandum of Understanding with River Heritage Conservancy and Demolition of 1235 Harrison Avenue

Scott Martin, with River Heritage Conservancy, came before the Council to discuss the MOU regarding Origin Park. Mr. Martin stated there are several mission goals: Transparency and Accountability; Long Term Landscape Discipline; Protect Public and Private Donations and Learn Together/Work Together.

Further discussion was held regarding the MOU and the length of the agreement. Mr. Martin stated it will be a 5 year MOU, but will renew automatically every 5 years until completion. Mr. Martin stated that renewal years will not be during any given election years, so as decisions are not politically motivated. Mr. Martin also stated there would be a formal, annual report given by the River Heritage Conservancy.

Further items discussed were Risk Management, Clark Blvd. being the #1 infrastructure, the demolition of 1235 Harrison Avenue and building headquarters. 2024 will be a possible opening and the area will be larger than the waterfront park area. Mr. Martin stated the he understands the timeline is aggressive, but this is due to rising costs in materials.
