A meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on February 15, 2022 at 7:00 P.M. in the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Clerk Treasurer Bob Leuthart, who chaired the meeting.

Consent Agenda:

-Approval of the Town Current & Pre-written, WW/SW Current & Pre-written, Bonds, Grants and Payroll.

-Minutes of the Joint Council Regular Meeting, Work Session and Executive Session held on February 1 and 3, 2022.

Council Member Gilkey made a motion to approve consent agenda. Council Member Henderson seconded the motion and was carried by 7-0 vote.

New Business:

Ordinance 2022-Z-01 Modifying Sign Regulations, Article 4, Division 200:

-An ordinance to change the aspects of the existing ordinance pertaining to signs was presented to the Council. Council Member Mustain made a motion to approve Ordinance 2022-Z-01.

Council Member Gilkey seconded the motion and was carried by a 7-0 vote.

Ordinance 2022-Z-02 Rezoning 6214 Applegate Lane:

-An ordinance to rezone 6214 Applegate Ln from manufactured Home Park to Business was presented to the Council. Council Member Stonecipher made a motion to approve Ordinance 2022-Z-02. Council Member Gilkey seconded the motion and was carried by a 7-0 vote.

Ordinance 2022-S-01 Amending Ordinance 2021-S-10 Regarding Economic Development Manager, court Bailiff and Assistant Police Chief:

-The Council was presented Ordinance 2022-S-01. Council Member Henderson made a motion to approve Ordinance 2022-S-01. Council Member Hauber seconded the motion and was carried by a 7-0 vote. A second reading resulted in Council Member Henderson making a motion to approve and Council Member Hauber seconding the motion. It was carried by a 7-0 vote.

Ordinance 2022-S-02 Amending Ordinance 2021-S-06 Regarding Job Classifications and Salary Ranges:

-The Council was presented an ordinance to amend certain salaries. Council Member Voignier made a motion to approve Ordinance 2022-S-02. Council Member Gilkey seconded the motion and was carried by a 7-0 vote. A second reading resulted in Council Member Voignier making a motion to approve and Council Member Gilkey seconding the motion. It was carried by a 7-0 vote.

Resolution 2022-R-04 Authorizing Use of Build/Operate/Transfer Provisions for Construction of Public Streets:

-A resolution to use the BOT process for construction of streets was presented to the Council. Council Member Gilkey made a motion to approve Resolution 2022-R-04. Council Member Henderson seconded the motion and was carried with a 7-0 vote.

Resolution 2022-R-05 Opposing Proposed Legislation Regarding Business Personal Property Tax:

-The Council was presented a resolution to oppose legislation that has been introduced in the 2022 Indiana Legislature. Council Member Gilkey made a motion to approve Resolution 2022-R-05. Council Member Hauber seconded the motion which resulted in a 5-0-2 vote with Council Member Voignier and Council Member Stonecipher abstaining.

Approval of the Purchase of a Jet/Vac Truck:

The Council was presented with a request by the Wastewater department to purchase a Jet/Vac Truck. Council Member Voignier made a motion to approve the purchase. Council Member Stonecipher seconded the motion which resulted in a 7-0 vote.

Approval of Contract for Birch & Emerald Storm Sewer:

-The Council was presented with a contract to improve storm water drainage in portions of Parkwood Subdivision. Council Member Mustain made a motion to approve the Contract to All Terrain Paving. Council member Voignier seconded the motion which resulted in a 7-0 vote.
