

26MINUTES OF MEETING OF

A meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on March 15, 2022 at 7:03 P.M. in the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President, Ryan Ramsey, who chaired the meeting.

Council Member Gilkey made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 2022-SW-01. Council Member Mustain seconded the motion which resulted in a 5-1 vote with Council Member Stonecipher voting Nay.

Staff made the recommendation to deny the appeal request for an adjustment. Council Member Hauber made a motion to deny the appeal for a wastewater adjustment at 420 W. Beckett. Council Member Henderson seconded the motion and was carried by a 6-0 vote.
