

MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL HELD ON
AUGUST 16, 2022

A work session of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on August 16, 2022 at 7:P.M. in the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President Ryan Ramsey, who chaired the meeting.

Update on Cottonwood Drive/Potters Lane Wastewater and Storm Water Project Plans

Associates from OHM Advisors, Heritage, and QK4 Engineering came before the Council to give a brief update on the Potters Lane (stormwater project) and Cottonwood Drive (pump station project). An overview of previous discussions and work on these projects was given, along with important information regarding road closures involved with these projects. A list of the road closures and dates will be posted on the Town's website in the near future. No action necessary as this was just an update for upcoming road closures.

Presentation and Discussion of Shop Local Program

Mike Mustain presented a highlight of a Shop Local app that could be used to incentivize repeat shopping in Clarksville businesses. Shoppers who have the phone app can accumulate rewards that can uniquely be spent in other Clarksville businesses. The intent is to reward any shopper from any community for shopping in Clarksville and show our Clarksville businesses we are here to help them succeed. The presentation was for informational purposes only and to gauge what level of interest the Council might have in such a program and if enough interest to try and schedule a presentation from the vendor. There appeared enough interest and efforts are being made to schedule an official presentation.

Update on Use of ARP Funds

Manger Baity gave a brief update on possible uses of ARP money, with the focus of Staff developing projects in which ARP funds could be used as a match for other grants. Any project that will use ARP funds will come before the Council for final approval. No action taken at this time.
