-Resolution 2022-R-22 Recognizing Jacob Arbutal for his Years of Service and Contribution to the Town of Clarksville. Council Member Henderson made a motion to approve 2022-R-22. Council Member Mustain seconded the motion, and it was carried by a 7-0 vote.

-Resolution 2022-R-23 Recognizing Nic Langford for his Years of Service and Contribution to the Town of Clarksville. Council Member Voignier made a motion to approve 2022-R-23. Council Member Stonecipher seconded the motion, and it was carried by a 7-0 vote.

Ordinance 2022-Z-08 Repealing Ordinance 2014-Z-03 and Adopting Revised Floodplain Management Regulations:

Staff recommends the Town approve Ordinance 2022-Z-08. From time to time the floodplain needs to be updated. The Indiana Dept. of Natural Resources developed a revised plan. Council Member Henderson made a motion to approve Ordinance 2022-Z-08. Council Member Gilkey seconded the motion and was carried by a 7-0 vote.

Ordinance 2022-Z-11 Rezoning Properties on Newman Ave from B-2 (business) to R-1 (Residential):

Staff recommends the Town approve Ordinance 2022-Z-11. Rezoning the property would correctly identify the use of the property. Council Member Gilkey made a motion to approve Ordinance 2022-Z-11. Council Member Henderson seconded and was carried by a 7-0 vote.

Ordinance 2022-G-12 Amending Clarksville Employee Handbook:

Staff recommends amending the Handbook to correct a discrepancy between the Worker's Compensation Insurance Policy and the EE Handbook. Council Member Voignier made a

motion to approve Ordinance 2022-G-12. Council Member Gilkey seconded the motion and was carried by 7-0 vote. A second reading resulted in Council Member Voignier making a motion to approve and Council Member Gilkey seconding the motion. The motion carried by a 7-0 vote.

Resolution 2022-R-24 Modifying the Membership of the Clarksville Youth Council:

Staff recommends the Council open the membership for the Youth Council to allow Sophomores and Freshmen to participate. Council Member Gilkey made a motion to approve Resolution 2022-R-24. Council Member Henderson seconded the motion which carried by a 7-0 vote.
