

MINUTES OF MEETING OF  
THE CLARKSVILLE TOWN COUNCIL  
HELD ON November 15, 2022

A meeting of the Clarksville Town Council was called to order on November 15, 2022 at 7:00 P.M. in the meeting room of the Clarksville Municipal Center Administration Building by Council President, Ryan Ramsey, who chaired the meeting.

**Public comments:**

-Jeffrey Donayel, 1801 Emerald Court, Clarksville. Mr. Donayel came before the Council to promote the Bikes or Bust program, being held at Coyle Chevrolet. Mr. Donayel encouraged everyone to participate and stated they are always looking for volunteers.

**Consent Agenda:**

-Approval of the Town Current & Pre-written, WW/SW Current & Pre-written, Bonds, Grants and Payroll.

Council Member Gilkey made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda.

Council Member Henderson seconded the motion and was carried by 6-0-1 vote with Council Member Stonecipher abstaining.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**Approval of Property, Casualty, Liability, Auto and Workers Compensation Insurance Renewal:**

Staff recommends the Town renew the insurance with Travelers for all lines except the Workers Compensation which is provided by IPEP. Council Member Mustain made a motion to approve the renewal. Council Member Gilkey seconded the motion, and it was carried by a 7-0 vote.

**Ordinance 2022-G-15 Declaring Dormant Accounts and Transferring Funds:**

Staff recommends the council approve the ordinance to close inactive funds and transfer necessary funds. Council Member Voignier made a motion to approve Ordinance 2022-G-15. Council Member Gilkey seconded the motion, and it was carried by a 7-0 vote.

**Ordinance 2022-G-16 Amending Section 306 of the Clarksville Employee Handbook:**

Staff recommends the Town approve the Ordinance to be in accordance with the Title 1 of the American Disabilities Act. Council Member Gilkey made a motion to approve Ordinance 2022-G-16. Council Member Voignier seconded the motion, and it was carried by a 7-0 vote.

**Ordinance 2022-BUD-06 Transfer of Funds Between Major Budget Classifications:**

Staff recommends the Town approve the Ordinance to transfer funds between major budget classifications. Council Member Gilkey made a motion to approve Ordinance 2022-BUD-06. Council Member Hauber seconded the motion and was carried by a 7-0 vote. A second reading resulted in Council Member Gilkey making a motion to approve and Council Member Hauber seconding the motion. It was carried by a 7-0 vote.

**Approval of a Funding Agreement for Improvements at 507-517 Eastern Blvd:**

Staff recommends the Town approve the funding agreement with 230 Holdings, LLC for the Streetscaping Improvements at 507-517 Eastern Blvd. Council Member Henderson made a motion to approve the Agreement and Council Member Hauber seconded the motion which was carried by a 7-0 vote.

**Authorization to Enter into a Lease Agreement for 1420 Vaxter Avenue:**

Council Member Henderson made a motion to table the Agreement. Council Member Voignier seconded the motion, and it was carried by a 6-1 vote with Council Member Stonecipher voting nay.

Council Member Gilkey made a motion to remove it from the table and approve the Agreement. Council Member Stonecipher seconded the motion, and it carried by a 6-1 vote with Council President Ramsey voting nay.
